**GROUNDINGS FOR OBJECTION SEC 13(1)**

13. (1) Any person upon whom a tax demand notice is served may within 21 days of such service lodge with the Commissioner an objection in writing against the levying of the tax, on the ground that the objector or the land to which the notice relates or any part of that land is not liable to tax, or that the amount of tax demanded is in excess of the amount of tax to which that person is liable.
